

THE PRAIRIE ENTHUSIASTS MANAGEMENT PLANS POLICY

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Adopted 5/10/2024

Chapters undertaking habitat management are required to have an approved management plan for each property. Chapters are responsible for drafting a plan using the available template and sending the plan to the chair of the Land Management Committee who will distribute copies to the members of the committee.

The Land Management Committee is composed of representatives from all the chapters. The committee will review the plan to ensure it includes 1. the date the plan was completed or updated, 2. identification of the conservation values of the site, 3. management goals, 4. the planned activities to achieve those goals and make their recommendations. Any changes will be incorporated into a new draft, which will be presented to The Prairie Enthusiasts Board. The Board will approve or reject the draft based on the recommendations of the Land Management Committee. The Board may also suggest additional changes. The management plan, when approved, is signed by the President of The Prairie Enthusiasts and a copy is held in the files of Chapter Support. Management plans will be developed, approved, and signed within one year of acquisition of fee title on any property.
