Public Hunting Code of Conduct

- Hunting is by approved registration only. Registration Requirements include Contact Information - name, email, mobile phone number, WDNR ID Number; Onsite Identity – make, model, and license plate number of vehicle; Hunting Designation and Season: year, whitetail deer bow/ gun, turkey, or other type identified.
- Follow all property site rules and hunting regulations.
- Only access areas posted with TPE signs. Know the field boundaries and do not trespass on the surrounding private land.
- Park wisely on the shoulder of public roads; there is no designated parking area. Do not block gate access.
- Access is limited to foot traffic only. Authorized motorized vehicles only.
- Avoid damage to property and vegetation. Cutting vegetation for shooting lanes etc., is prohibited.
- Constructing or erecting blinds, stands, or other structures is prohibited. Portable blinds, stands, or other structures shall avoid damage to trees and shall be removed when you leave. A portable stand or blind in use but temporarily unoccupied must be clearly marked with identifying contact information, or it may be removed.
- Support Ethical Responsible Hunting-Report violations.

- Be aware of invasive species and prevent the spread; clean boots, equipment, etc. before entering and leaving the Sylvan property.
- Game cameras and similar devices are not allowed on the property.
- Do not build campfires or camp on the property.
- Do not litter. Pack out spent shells or casings. Leave no trace.
- Be aware that site management, scientific research, and multiple public uses may occur during hunting seasons. While hunting is allowed, it is not the priority use. Be ethical, courteous, and safe.
